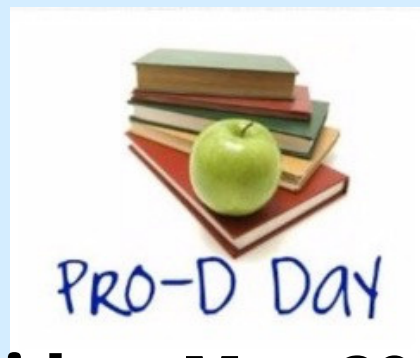

Right now, our Track Meet is a GO!



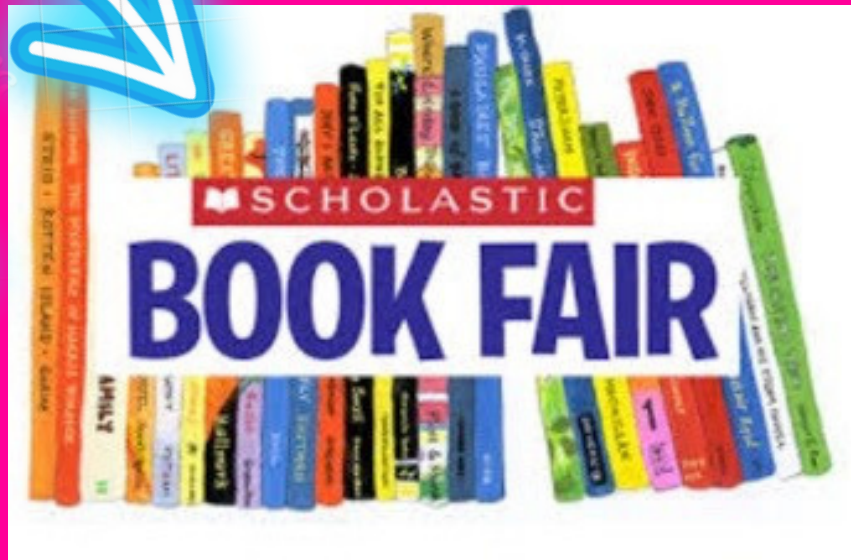

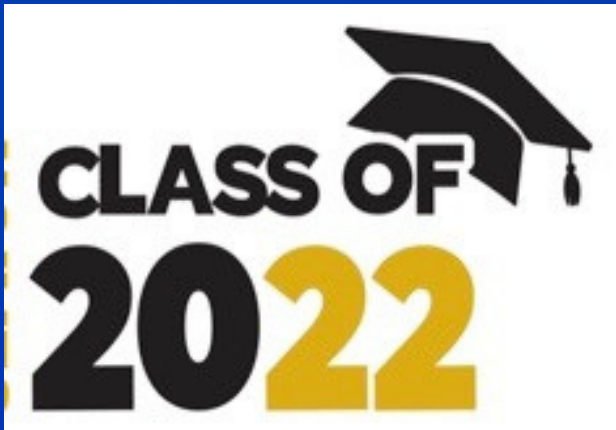

Grade 7 Photos!

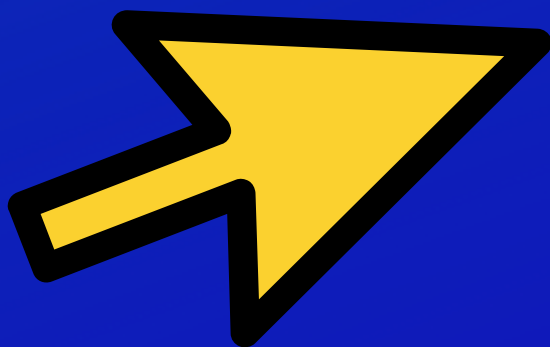
