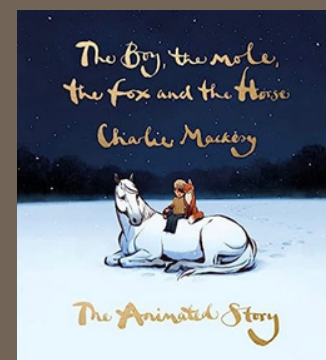

Tuesday, September 5th: Welcome Back to School!

Returning Kingswood Students from Grades 1 to 7 attend from 8:45-9:45 am

- Please report to last year's classroom door or meeting spot at 8:45 am
- Families, please pick up your child(ren) from these same doors for Tuesday only

New to Kingswood Grades 1 to 7 attend from 8:45-9:45 am

- Please meet at the front entrance to the school; a staff member will meet you there and bring your child into the library
- Students will be walked down to an age appropriate classroom where they will stay for the week
- A teacher will let you know which door to pick up your child at 9:45 am.

Kindergarten Students Attend from 1:00 – 2:00 pm

- For our Kindergarten students, please line up at the following door outside: Door Number 9. They should also be picked up from this door at 2:00 pm.
- Kindergarten students will follow their gradual entry schedule which will be sent out via paper copy and email to our Kindergarten families

Wednesday, September 6th and onwards

- All students in Grades 1 – 7 will attend for full days, which is from 8:45 am to 2:45 pm.
- Students are to pack a snack, lunch and water bottle
- Our Kindergarten students will follow the Gradual Entry Schedule
- All students will report to, and be dismissed from, the same classroom doors or designated meeting area during this week until they are placed into their new classes for the year, which will likely be on Friday, September 8th

(Please note – Grade 1 students (last year's K students) will be in other classrooms on September 6, 7, 8 so that new Kindergarten students can participate in gradual entry in the Kindergarten classroom.
