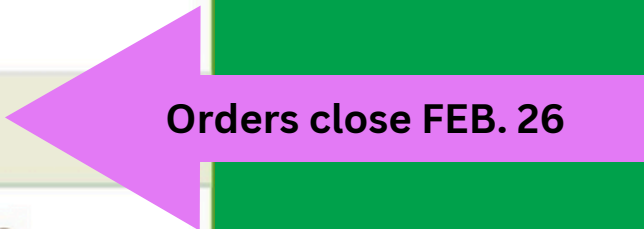

Additionally, there will be four open houses and a virtual session. Feedback gathered will help shape the priorities that will guide the district for the next five years.

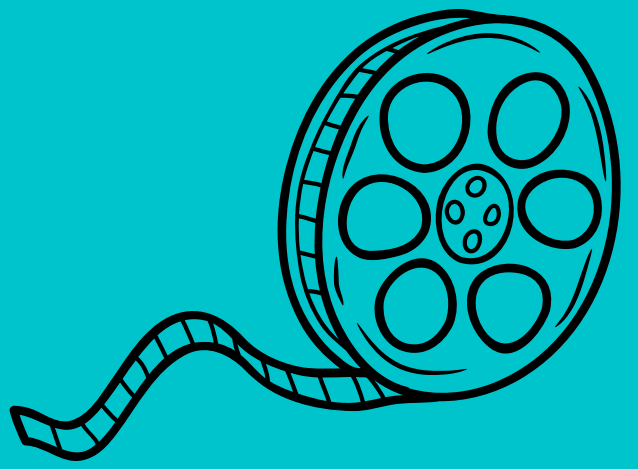

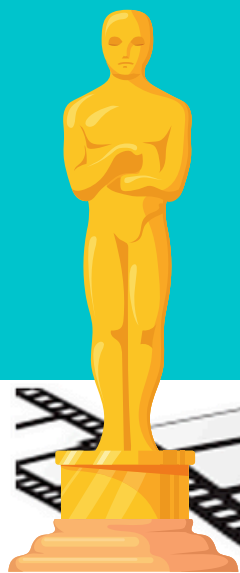
Dear families,

- > Give credit

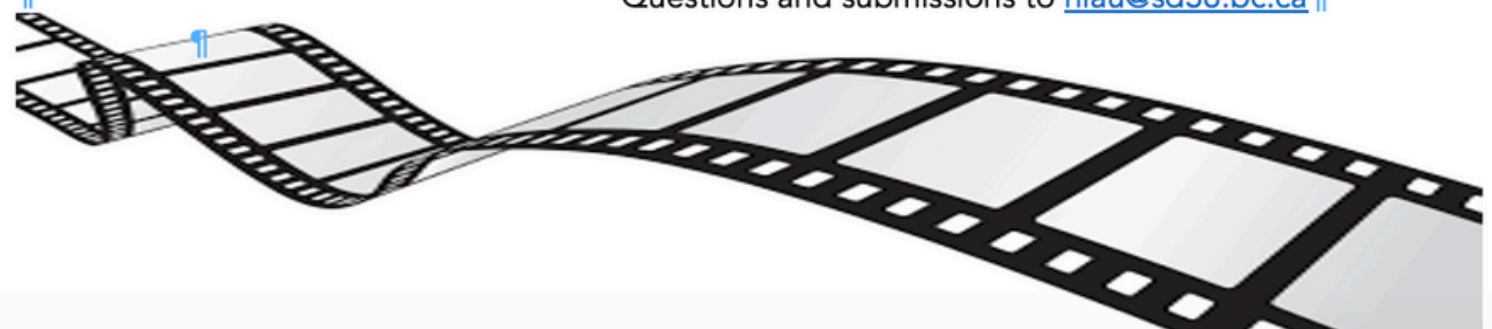
Submissions in movie format (mp3, avi, etc) due by: **March 3**

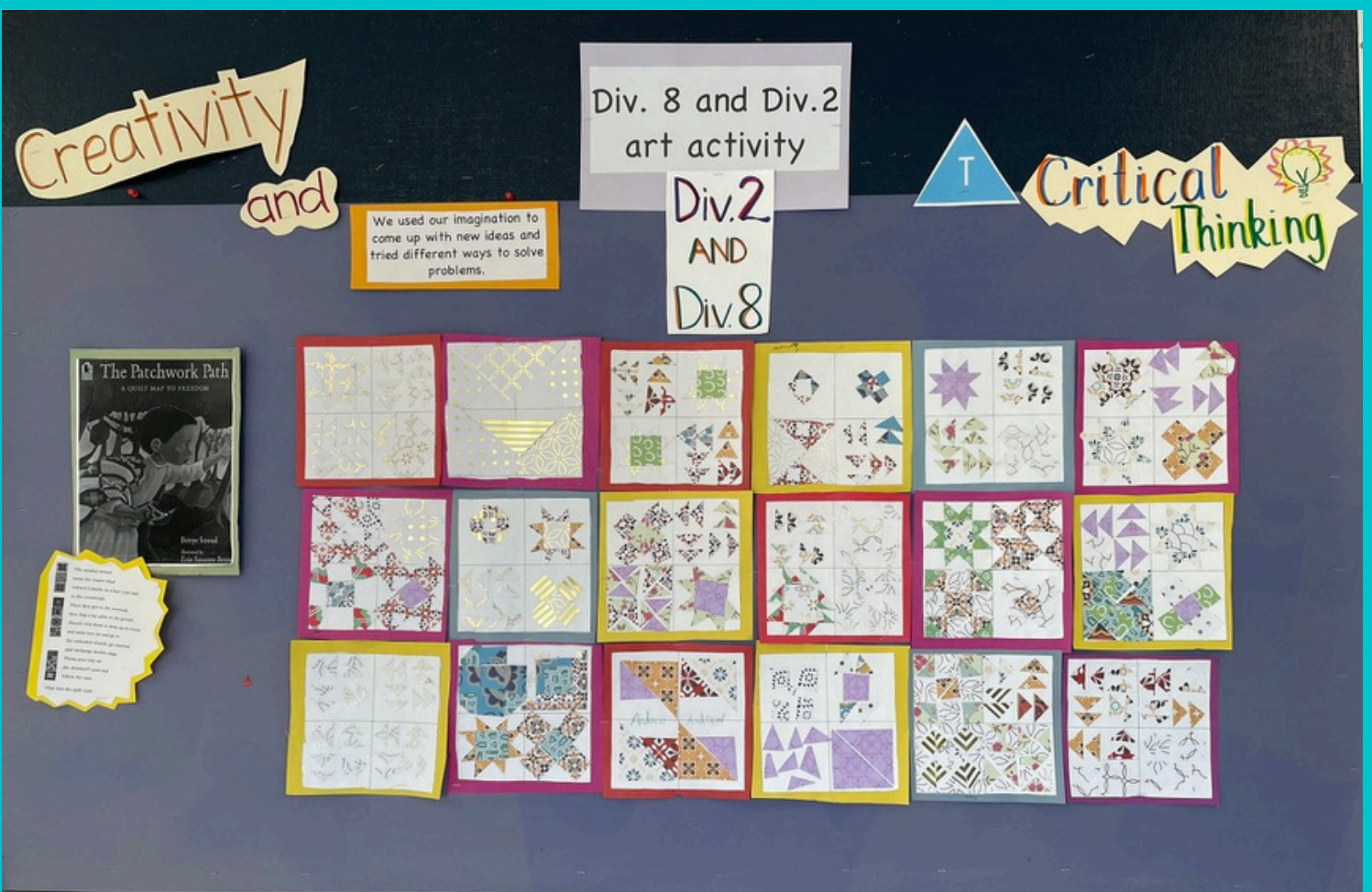
