- → Give·credit·¶

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

E ABSENCES ABSENCES

A reminder about The Richmond School District Policy on extended absences. If you are requesting an extended absence for your child(ren), the following applies. The District policy regarding extended absences from school state that when you are away for more than a four-week period of time or 20 continuous school days, they will be removed from the school register and will need to be re-registered when they return. The impact of this policy is that there may not be space in the school or in the classroom that your child is currently registered in. Please review the following guidelines if your child is absent from the school for longer than a four-week period of time: Your child may be removed from the school register and you will need to re-register for your catchment school upon your return to Richmond.

local media to share information. Listen to local radio stations and follow local news outlets online to also get

information about the impact of severe weather or emergencies in our schools. If snowfall begins while school is in session, in most circumstances, schools will remain OPEN until the end of the school day.
