This year, we are planning The Kingswood School Challenge:

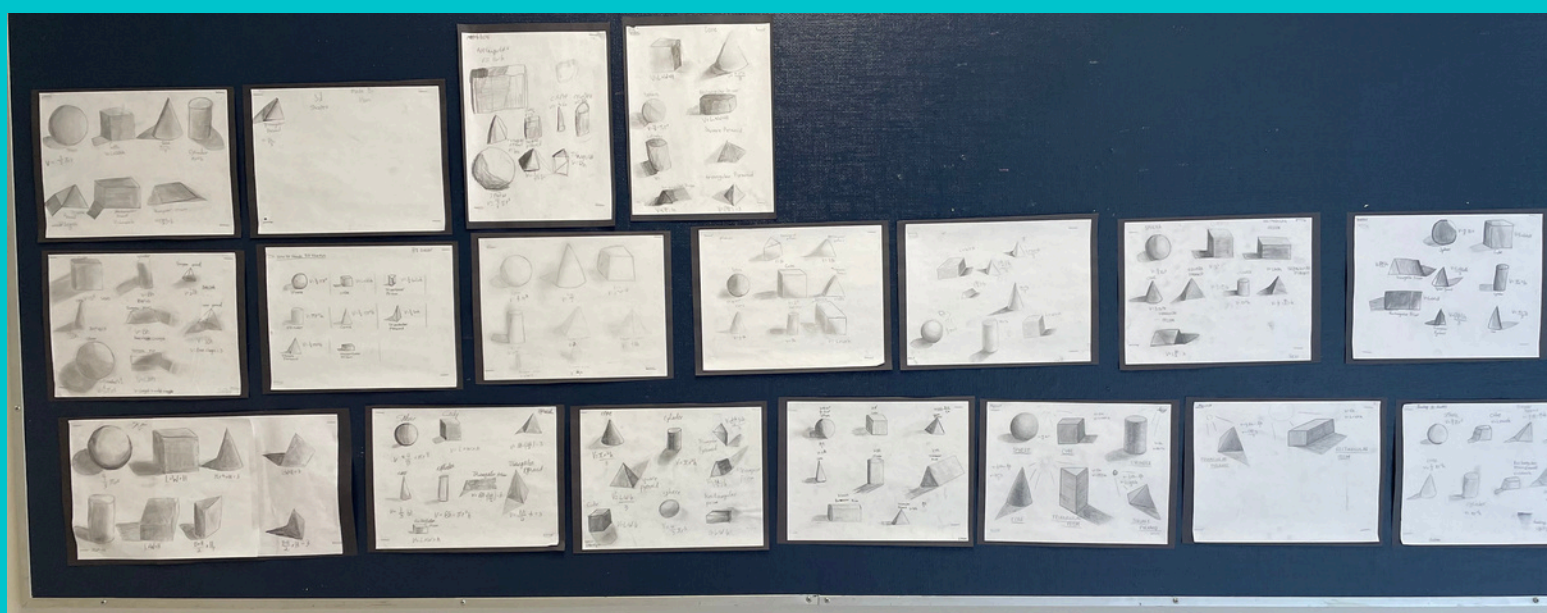
If we raise at least \$5,000, there will be a school-wide freezie party!!
